SILVERWOOD LAKE CANOE TREK

June 26-27, 2009

Description: This is a two-day canoeing training trip. This is another great opportunity to practice on some beautiful open water. We will be camping Friday night at Mojave River Forks Campground near Hesperia and spending Saturday on Silverwood Lake. Everyone planning to attend the Sacramento River Canoe Trek and those who just want to have fun should attend.

Prerequisites: In order to canoe or kayak, participants must have passed the BSA Swim Test within the last 6 months and be familiar with Safety Afloat principles.

Meals: We will be having Friday dinner on the road, Saturday breakfast in camp, lunch on the lake and dinner on the road home. Bring money for one or two road meals.

Trek Fee: \$25.00 per person this includes camping fee, Troop Trek fee, food (not meals on the road), transportation, and entrance fee.

Schedule:

Friday, June 26

6:00 pm Assemble at Scout House
6:30 pm Depart Scout House (Dinner on Road. You may eat before leaving or bring a sack dinner, if you prefer)
8:30 pm Arrive at Mojave River Forks Campground and set up camp

Saturday, June 27

6:00 am Reveille, break camp, breakfast
8:30 am Depart for Silverwood Lake
9:00 am Arrive at Silverwood Lake begin canoe skills and touring
12:00 pm Lunch on lakeside
4:00 pm Leave Silverwood Lake (Dinner on Road)
6:30 pm Arrive back at Scout House

Equipment: Class A Uniform shirt, standard car camping equipment, day pack with 10 essentials (page 207 of the Scout Handbook) (**SUN PROTECTION**, hat, water clothes, swimsuit, **WATER**, sunscreen)

We will also need a vehicle that can tow the council canoe trailer. The canoes will need to be picked up in advance and be ready to depart with the group by 6:30 pm on Friday. Please contact Greg Godwin if you are able to assist with this task.
